

# Instructions for Instructors

1 Simply ensure the Dreamer's (student's) name and class information is filled in to get their picture!

2 This is the creative spark for the picture:  
The Dream can be as simple as 4 words or as detailed as 4 sentences  
(see examples to the right)


3 This section is *entirely* optional: Dreamers may further refine their concepts choosing from these styles  
Select only 1 "or" choice per section to avoid contradicting choices!










